Description

The PS H hospital pattern plaster sink with plain top complies with HTM64: Sanitary assemblies (2006) and is used in connection with plaster preparation and disposal. The wall mounted unit comprises a plain stainless steel top with anti-drip edge which incorporates either a right or left rectangular sink bowl without overflow. Formed as part of the sink bowl is an integrated round sump with a lift out partially perforated stainless steel basket and cover. Optional tap holes and front support legs can be provided.

Construction

The plaster sink is manufactured without joints and crevices from grade 304 stainless steel with all exposed surfaces polished to a satin finish.

The plain top is formed with a continuous anti-drip edge and turn down to all sides and is supplied with wall mounting brackets. Positioned at the right or left hand end of the top is a rectangular sink bowl which has no tap holes and no overflow. Formed as an integral part of the sink bowl is a round sump supplied with a lift out partially perforated stainless steel basket and cover and an unslotted flush grated waste fitting. As an option the plaster sink can be provided with tap holes and stainless steel front support legs.
