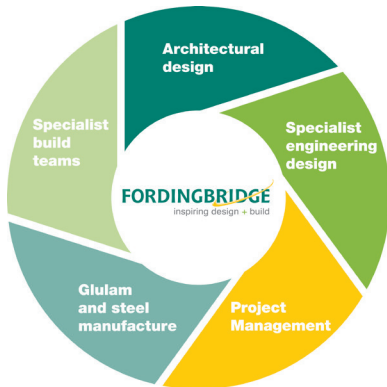

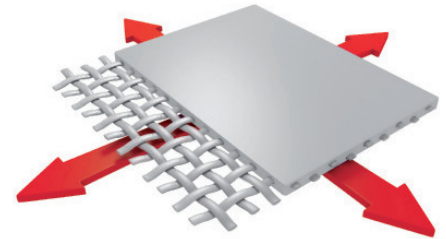
Fordingbridge focus on sustainable design and build. Because of this we want our canopies to be as naturally well-lit as possible, reducing the need for electrical lighting.


We offer two roof options for our canopies; a 16mm triple-wall polycarbonate and our exclusive Opal 60 fabric.

Designed specifically for Fordingbridge, Opal 60 allows an industry leading 60% natural daylight, blocks UV for both the safety of participants and longevity of the playing surface, and also provides sound attenuation to ensure a pleasant playing experience.

This durable membrane also features a smooth lacquered surface, enabling self-cleaning and easy maintenance .

Both Opal 60 and our polycarbonate options are fire retardent, resistant to UV and have a lifespan allowing for decades of play.
