



Each steam bath is unique

wedi offers a multitude of options for designing your own personal steam bath. From the choice of the cabin geometry to the roof design, comfortable seating or bath furniture to the technical equipment, every detail can be designed exactly how you want it.

The wedi base material consists of a waterproof XPS foam core with a glass fibre-reinforced and mortar-covered surface. It allows for a wide range of structures to be brought to life: wall and roof element can be coated in the factory, milled recesses for cables can be incorporated into the individual modules and lighting or sound technology can also be integrated.




3. Logistics

All the finished components of your new steam bath are delivered directly from our UK warehouse – direct to site if required. You can rely on our dedicated transport service ensuring that your schedule is always kept to.



4. Construction phase on site

In order to ensure seamless installation on site, each steam bath is built on a trial basis in the wedi factory before delivery. The individual elements are clearly marked, making assembly on site significantly easier. wedi is happy to continue supporting you on the construction site if required.



5. Commissioning

Ready to use. After final assembly and subsequent checking of all functionalities, the steam bath can then be directly tiled and put into use as planned.

Wall structures according to customer requirements


Individual wall structures (with and without integrated technology or reinforcements for attachments later) can be implemented in almost all formats and thicknesses.

Drain technology

The wedi drain technology is already integrated into the floor element in the factory. The position, of course, can be individually selected. In addition, the slope is already adapted to the drain position therefore can be directly tiled.

Whether round or square, domed, one-piece, multi-piece or completely individual – the shape of the roof structure is entirely up to you.

Integrated lighting technology

wedi has its own high-quality portfolio of lighting systems for your steam bath. 

All supply lines are waterproof and are placed with millimetre precision. Every detail is precisely defined in advance and approved by you before the final implementation.




A floor that makes the difference

Individual floor elements in a leading role


Floor elements serve as important design elements in spa areas. The wedi floor elements are perfect tile backers, individually tailored to the conditions and do not only function as foundations for steam baths, but with their prefabricated slope, they also serve as a draining plane with a unique, high-performance wedi drain technology featuring either point or linear drainage. In addition, the floor elements act as the footprint for the entire cabin structure and, thanks to the special mounting grooves, ensure the secure and precise installation of the wall elements. As an alternative to the floor element, wedi can deliver metal rails for the existing supporting surface with the contour of the selected wall structure.








Form and function combined

Depending on the installation location and design concept, the wedi design team offer a variety of wall structures for individual steam baths. The classic square and rectangular shapes are polygonal while the round and free-form shape variants are made to measure, of course all in line with static requirements – this results in countless options for designing inviting steam rooms. Whether as a standard or as an individual design with recesses or reinforcements for bearing the load of e.g. handrails to be installed later, with integrated seats and empty conduits or perhaps with individual technology – the degree of prefabrication can be adjusted for each element. Quick installation is guaranteed thanks to the accuracy of fit and the lightness of the materials from wedi.




e.g. rectangular



Roof elements with required degree of prefabrication

The roof is one of the most important design elements for every steam bath. Its shape and colour, in combination with light and vapour, later ensure a wonderful atmosphere. Whether pointed or flat, curved or square – there are no limitations to your ideas. Thanks to modern milling techniques used in the wedi production, any technical requirements can be taken into account from the beginning and integrated into the structure. The degree of prefabrication can be freely chosen in the process. Alongside the simple standard design, all recesses required for electrical cables can be incorporated in the factory and any desired technology, e.g. lighting technology can also be integrated.


e.g. domed roof




e.g. tunnel roof



Large selection of wellness elements

For perfect furnishing of the steam room, wedi offers a wide selection of prefabricated wellness elements. From benches in a wide variety of forms through unusual loungers to practical accessories such as niches and glass doors, steam baths can be furnished and enhanced however you like. All elements can be ordered in the standard design or manufactured individually to the desired dimensions.

The individually tileable Sanoasa loungers give the wellness area its individual touch.




Technical integration from A-Z

All components are individually prefabricated

A modern steam bath includes an attractive design concept with technically well thought out furnishing. That's why the wedi system components and modules can be optionally equipped with effective lighting technology such as accentuated LED spots, colour-changing RGB spotlights and bendable lighting strips and well-engineered steam technology, high quality fittings, heating and ventilation lines or even high-end speakers.


All moulded parts and design elements are individually manufactured to the customer's specifications and of course the degree of prefabrication – here as well – is determined by the customer.

Standard design




Whether for individual wall and roof elements or finished furnishing and design elements, standard design wedi system components are delivered direct to the construction site without any additional prefabrication measures in the factory and can be installed quickly and easily on site. Standard design means that these elements do not include integrated technology, therefore the waterproof XPS foam core, glass fibre-reinforced and mortar-coated surfaces can be tiled directly after installation without additional sealing measures.

Technology preparations




The necessary recesses and ducts, e.g. for surface-mounted and flush-mounted fitting, massage nozzles, or heating hoses can be planned in advance and incorporated into the system modules so that it is possible to start directly with installation on site.

Integrated technology



The required technology, such as halogen/LED spotlights or optical fibres, speaker systems and cabling for electrical or hot water heating systems are integrated and delivered directly from the factory.



Individual starry sky

For an impressive starry sky, the connections and recesses for the light spots are incorporated into the ceiling structure in the factory and are equipped with the necessary electrical cables.





Speakers

Modern speaker and audio systems can be planned right from the factory and the necessary recesses are incorporated into the wall and ceiling modules.



Wide variety of spots & lighting strips

Whether in the ceiling, in the floor, in the walls, or even in loungers and benches, the necessary electrical connections for practical LED spots, flexible LED lighting strips made from aluminium, or spotlight sets with Swarovski crystals, including individual control technology for all lighting, can be integrated into the design of the steam room.

Heating technology

Installation of electrical or hot-water heating systems can either be integrated or planned for in the factory.

Steam technology

All interfaces for connecting common and brand-independent steam technology are planned in the factory and the necessary recesses are incorporated in accordance with the customer's requirements.



Fittings and nozzles


Upon request, the steam rooms can be equipped with recesses and ducts in the factory to allow for high-quality fittings from well-known manufacturers.






Look and feel. Choose your surface.

wedi offers a wide range of different types of coating for all steam bath components. The basis for the individually produced modules are the wedi components, coated with mortar on both sides. In order to establish a vapour barrier to protect the structure and for a colourful final coating, wedi offers a wide range of options which can optionally be applied in the factory or directly on site.



Mortar coating in the factory

The individually manufactured steam bath elements in the standard design are delivered with a mortar coating on both sides. The customer can then decide on additional coatings, such as tiles, mosaics or colourful final coatings.



Interior epoxy resin coating as a vapour barrier

For steam baths, wedi recommends consistent implementation of a vapour barrier in order to prevent damage from vapour. A sanded epoxy resin coating is therefore applied to the interior side of the steam bath elements, unless the customer wants an epoxy resin coating applied on the construction site. In this case, wedi delivers the elements with a fabric-reinforced mortar layer on the room side.



Roof coatings in RAL shades


For the roof of the steam bath, wedi offers a lastingly reliable coating with a modern flake structure which can be painted in a variety of RAL colours. Elements such as speakers or ducts are also painted upon request so that the overall appearance is consistent. Since the coating is applied in the wedi factory, no additional work steps are required on site. Find a few examples of our coat finishes below.





Comfortable foot basins or child-safe paddling pools with the desired degree of prefabrication.



05 Benches and loungers

Prefabricated elements or individual free-form shapes, with ducts, cables or integrated technology planned in the factory upon request.

06 Wall structures

Stable wall structures which can be implemented in almost any shape for partitions.

07 Steam baths

Unique steam rooms, customisable with regard to the degree of prefabrications, shape, technical equipment and colour.

08 Underwater structures

Underwater elements, e.g. loungers, steps, etc. produced to match the design concept.
