The practical spreading rate may be lower as this depends on factors such as the porosity and roughness of the surface to be painted and material losses

during application.

PREPARATION

Concrete All surfaces should be clean, dry, sound and free from contaminants. Concrete

surfaces should be roughened first to provide a good "key" for the paint. This can be done mechanically by abrading or blasting, or chemically, using Acid Etch. These processes will have the advantage in addition to preparing the surface of also removing dirt and laitance. Newly laid concrete should be left to cure prior to painting, we recommend 1 month per 3cm of slab thickness, up to 3 months. Apply 1 coat thinned with 10% clean water to prime the

surface.

Asphalt and Tarmac All surfaces must be clean, dry, sound and free from contaminants.

Apply 1 coat thinned with 10% clean water to prime the surface.

Existing painted

surfaces

Surfaces must be cleaned, degreased, sanded to ensure an adequate "key" is produced and free from anything that could interfere with the adhesion of the material to be applied. Remove all loose and flaking material and treat

bare areas as new substrate and prepare accordingly.
