Stone slips

Stone slips can be installed with or without Eurobrick's panel systems.

Stone can be used on whole projects or to provide architectural detail such as quoins or feature bands. We can source natural and reconstituted stone products to suit project requirements.

All stone products are manufactured/cut to order. Corner stone slips are also available on most products. Lead times vary, please enquire at earliest opportunity.





Straight slips, corners and angles

All brick types from the Classic and Britannia ranges are available as straight slips and 90° pistol corners as illustrated.

Britannia range straight slips are typically 215x65x15mm and Classic range are typically 215x65x(20-25mm) depending on brick type.

Special pieces such as face and bed corner/s or special angles (eg. 135°) can be "cut and stuck" to order.



Cut to order

Where a project requires a particular brick type, not matched by any of the blends carried as stock at Eurobrick we can source these and have them cut to fit within our systems.

Slips can be cut from any FL grade (frost resistant) brick. Slips are usually cut 20mm to 25mm thick, depending on the characteristics of the brick, and can be used with our cladding systems provided the height of the bricks does not exceed 65mm.

Terms and Conditions

Any quantity can be considered for cutting. Pistol corners can also be provided. Please contact us to discuss lead times, costs, terms and conditions relating to orders for specially cut bricks.

Pointing mortar

Our A1-rated, non-combustible Europoint mortar is a specially formulated, easy-to-use dry pack pointing mortar, available in eight colours.

Coloured mortars enable the desired aesthetic effect to be achieved either by complementing or contrasting the brick colour.


Europoint® is a pre-prepared cement based mortar, just add water and mix. It has been developed for application by gun or grout bag injection. Pointing bags, tips and guns are available.

Panel systems

Our panel systems offer the perfect solution for exterior or interior use and can be fitted to most substrate types with or without insulation.







Lightweight, external wall insulation system suitable for new build, modular and retrofit projects.



Designed for use as a rainscreen on structures requiring a cavity.



An economy external wall insulation system ideal for domestic and renovation purposes.



For interior use, the plasterboard backer panel can be fixed to a steel or timber framed wall.

Installation



1. The backer panel is mechanically fixed to the substrate. Panels and fixings vary according to the system and application.



2. The brick slips are attached with an adhesive, which varies according to the system. The horizontal ribs align and support the brick slips.



3. Our specially formulated Europoint pointing mortar is then piped or gunned into the brick joints.



4. Mortar is tooled in the manner of traditional pointing. Once it has set the brickwork is brushed down to finish.

Important

It should be noted that as the materials used in the manufacture of bricks, stone and mortars are from natural sources, variations in shade and dimension can occur. This should not be viewed as a fault in production and should be taken into account at the design stage of the project.

Whilst every reasonable effort is made to ensure that Classic range slips and other specially cut bricks and pistol corners are supplied to a tolerance of +/- 2mm of the prescribed thickness, it is possible that some deviation from size tolerance may be experienced in thickness, shape and length of bricks.

Installers must carefully monitor all materials used and reject any sub-standard or unsuitable material prior to installation. **Eurobrick Systems Limited** will not accept any liability for any costs arising from the rejection of materials once they have been installed.

Prices of brick slips will vary dependent on blend chosen and volume required.

Our brick slip range is constantly evolving. From time to time, products illustrated in this guide may be discontinued or superseded and new products may be added. For up to date product information, please visit our website or call us to check current stock levels.

Mortar

The mortar colours shown are indicative. Please note, colour variations can be expected due to the porosity of the brick, finishing techniques, mixing procedures and weather conditions (temperature, humidity and wind) at time of application. Coloured mortars will change the appearance of brickwork.
