






NOTES:

Fairface Masonry

- 1. In general, all vertical faces are fairfaced, tops and bottoms of units are not, except where indicated.
- The hatched areas on the illustrations indicate factory cut faces. On fairfaced products factory cutting creates a different texture from the main faces of the units.
- 3. Those units sub referenced as L or R are available left or right-handed.

Textured Masonry

- 1. The darker tint areas on the illustrations indicate faces which are Textured as standard. All lintels are textured to soffit.
- Additional requirements for Texturing should be indicated on the Architects Drawing.
- The hatched areas on the illustrations indicate factory cut units. On Textured units the additional finishing process ensures that factory cut faces have an appearance complementary to the other finished faces.

Polished and Burnished Masonry

- 1. The darker tint areas on the illustrations indicate faces which are polished or burnished as standard.
- 2. Additional requirements for Polishing or Burnishing should be indicated on the Architects Drawing.
- The Florentine[®] and Venezia[™] finishes are available in all designs with the exception of bond beams and lintels.
- 4. The hatched areas on the illustrations indicate factory cut units. On Florentine[®] and Venezia[™] units the additional finishing process ensures that factory cut faces have an appearance complementary to the other finished faces.
- On Florentine[®] and Venezia[™] units the thicknesses indicated are nominal, as actual thickness will be reduced by approximately 2mm during polishing. However, cut face dimensions are actual in allowance of this.
