



Because all our doors and doorsets are made to measure, you can specify the finish to the door, frame and architrave. The choice of finish may be driven by function (water resistance, easy to clean, anti-microbial) or by appearance (colour, woodgrain, texture). If you choose a veneered finish, there is scope to get quite creative by specifying one or more timber species, the direction of the grain, the way the veneers are matched and the lacquer or stain used. This data sheet will show you some of the options available, but it is by no means exhaustive.

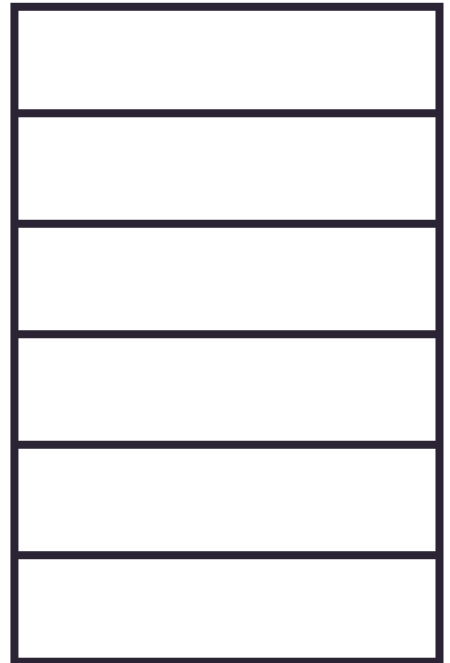

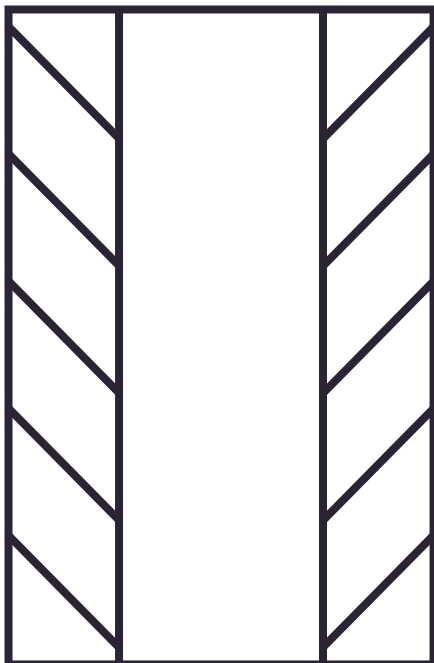
Central panel surrounded by vertical and horizontal strips



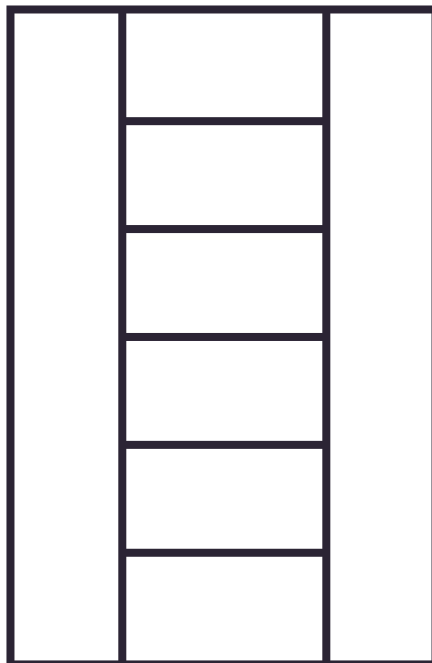
Vertical strips



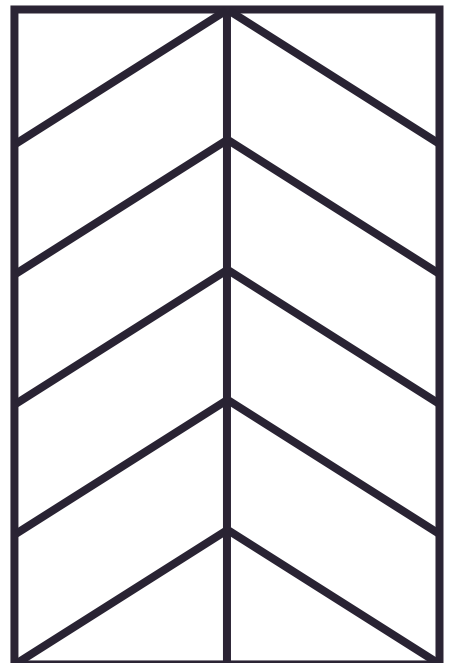
Horizontal strips
