When you have completed your tour of the brewery what better way to sample the produce than in the calm surrounds of the upper deck patio area. Upon initial installation the patio doors, shown here, were giving cause for concern - especially on windy days.

The original door closers were not up to the task of properly controlling large outward opening doors, which can so often pose problems in public areas. Fortunately, Relcross Door Controls has a wealth of experience in this area and we were able to provide a proven solution from LCN Closers.

The 4110 *Smoothee*® is LCN's best performing heavy duty closer designed specifically for institutional and other rugged high traffic applications. This closer suits perimeter doors to 1067mm (max. weight 136 kilos) and is fully adjustable through power sizes 1 to 5. All 4000 series closers have back check, closing speed and latch action hydraulic controls. The CNS arm feature (shown here) stops the door at 90° on the opening arc to protect against the wind taking the door and causing damage to the door/frame or injury to those adjacent to the door.
